Mass Registration in May

During May St Mark's Youth Group will be trialling a new system of COVID Mass Registration. It will be a combination of QR scan codes and a registration card for the parishioners who do not own a smart phone or who struggle with technology.

QR Code Process:

- When you are seated in your pew—please take note of your seat number and the QR code that is below it.
- You will need a QR Reader App—these can be downloaded for free from your phone's App Store.
- Open the QR Reader App on your phone. Frame the QR code in the app's window.
- Select 'Open Link'
- Type in your name, phone number, address and seat number.
- This process must be repeated for every member in your household group.
- If you need help—please raise your hand and a Youth Group member will come to your assistance.

Written Card Registration Process:

- If you do not own a smart phone or have not brought it with you, please raise your hand. A Youth Group member will give you a Registration card and a pencil. Your seat number is at the back of your pew. Please record this number and all other details on the card. Other members of your household can be recorded on the reverse of the Registration card.
- The completed card can be given to a member of the Youth Group when it is completed or left on the church pew when you leave Mass.

Mass Count Census:

During the month of May every parish in Australia conducts a census to determine how many Catholics are attending Mass each week. During the offertory volunteers will be counting the number of people in each pew. This data will also enable us to check the compliancy with the new COVID registration process. For the final two week ends of May we have also been asked to collect information on the gender and age of all those who attend Mass.
