Reader: That those who mourn will feel God's presence in their sorrow.

Reader: That our loved ones who have died will receive eternal glory in your presence.
(pause) Lord hear us

Celebrant: Loving God you sent Jesus to be our teacher and our saviour. Hear our prayers and form us as a community of faith where all in need are welcomed. We ask this through Christ our Lord.
