Reader: That the needy, the exploited, the abused, and the victims of war may come to know their freedom and dignity as children of God.

Reader: That with the gift of humility we have the courage to acknowledge our own faults and our need of God's love and mercy.

Reader: That the Spirit of God will touch all who are sick or wounded and restore them to wholeness. **(pause) Lord Hear Us**

Reader: That God's mercy will grant eternal life to those who have died.

Priest: Lord, we ask You to awaken our spirits to knowledge, understanding and courage and help us to spread Your message of love to all people. We ask this through Christ our Lord.
